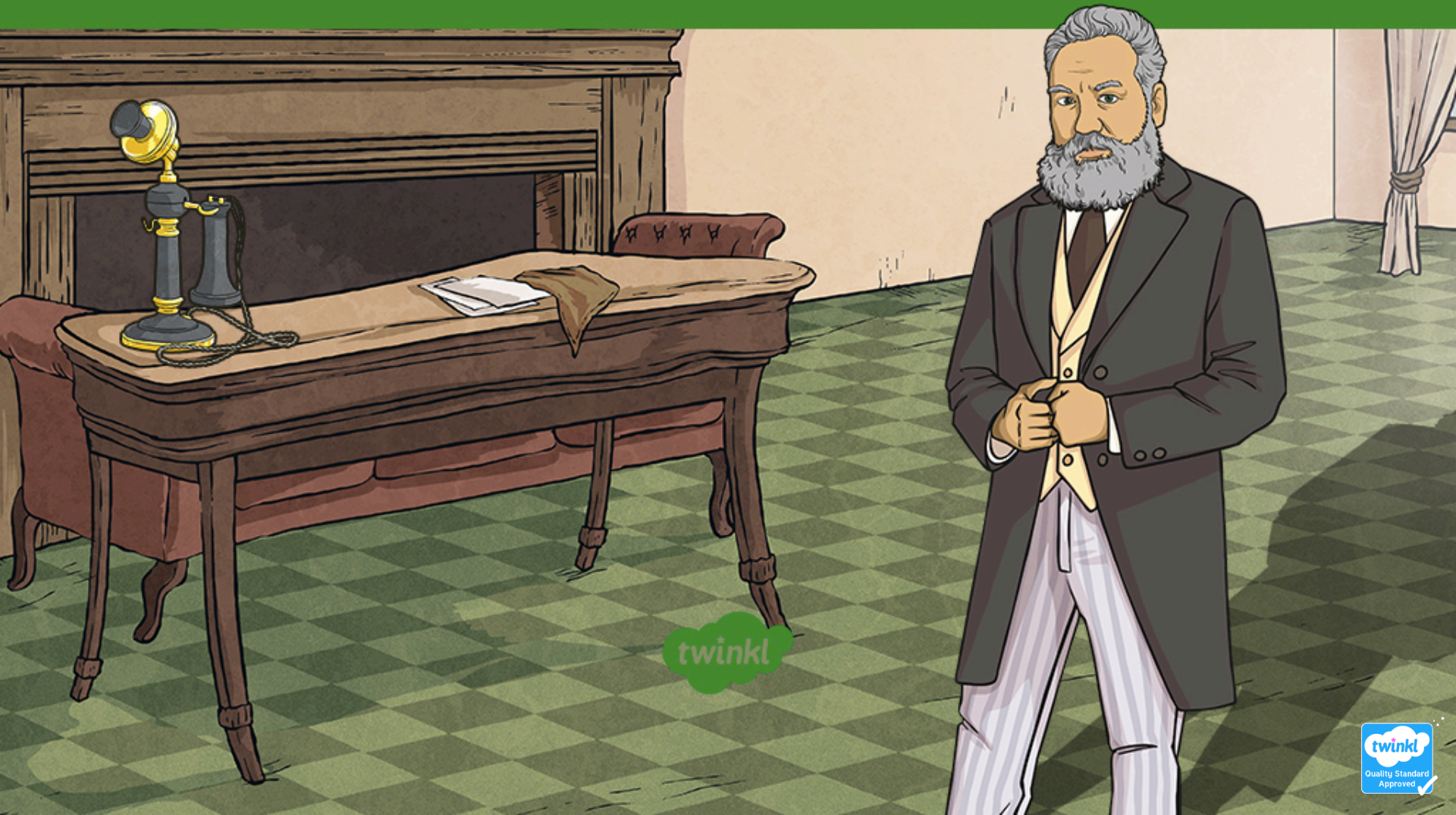

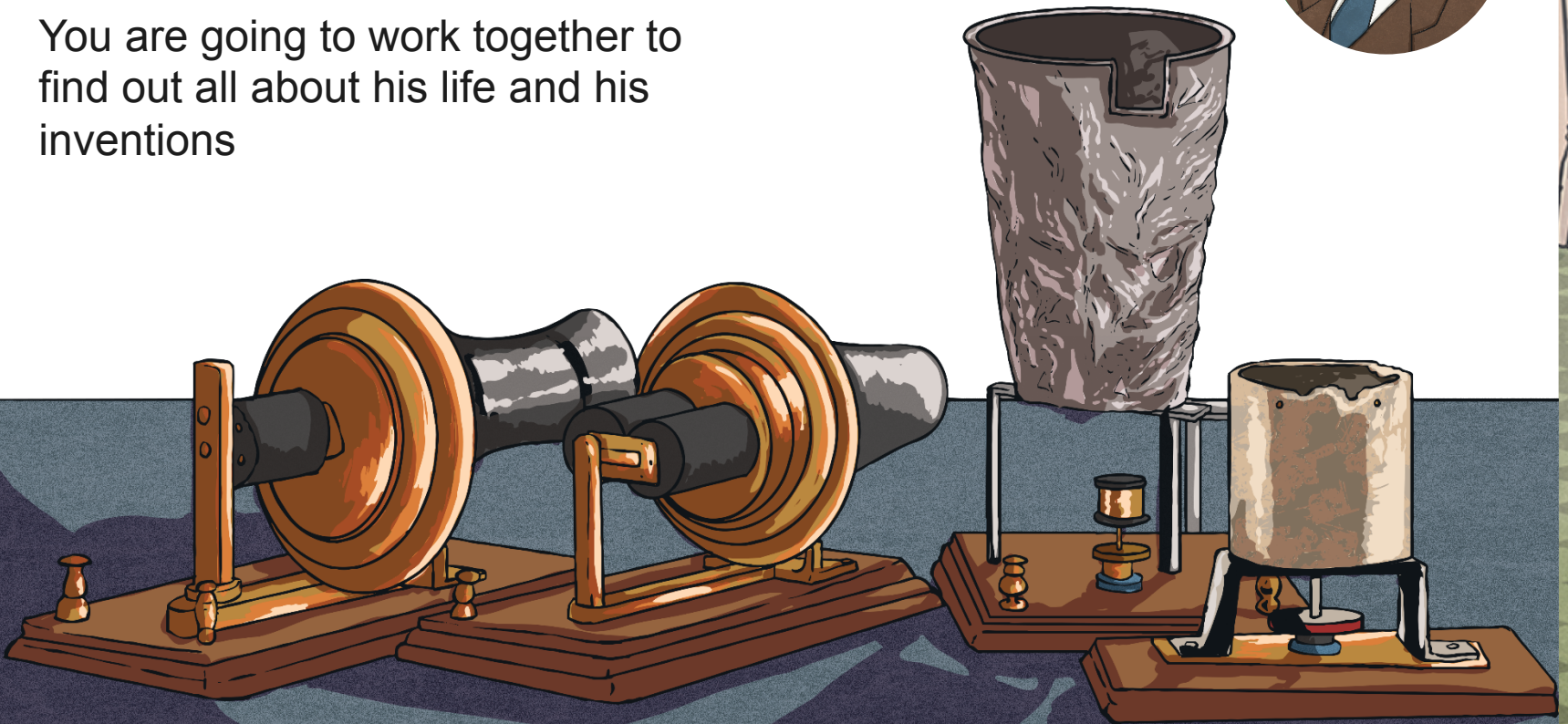


Alexander Graham Bell

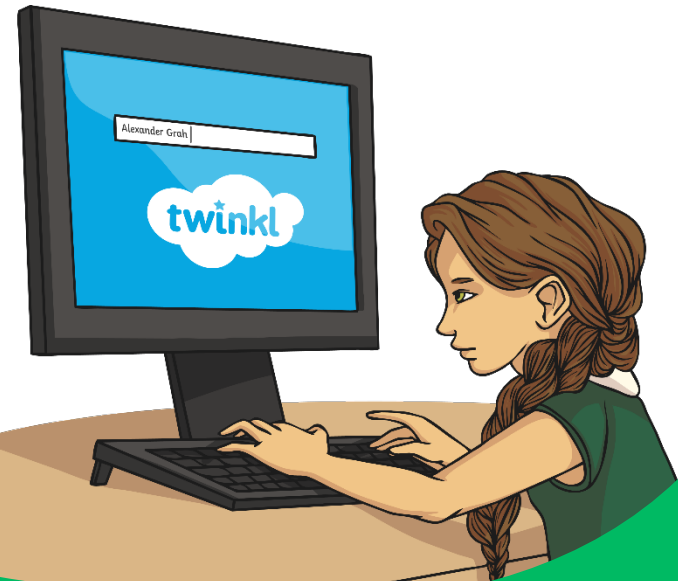

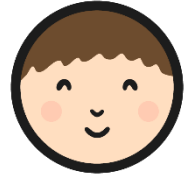

Draw Alexander Graham Bell's body underneath, so that when you hold it up you will look like him!

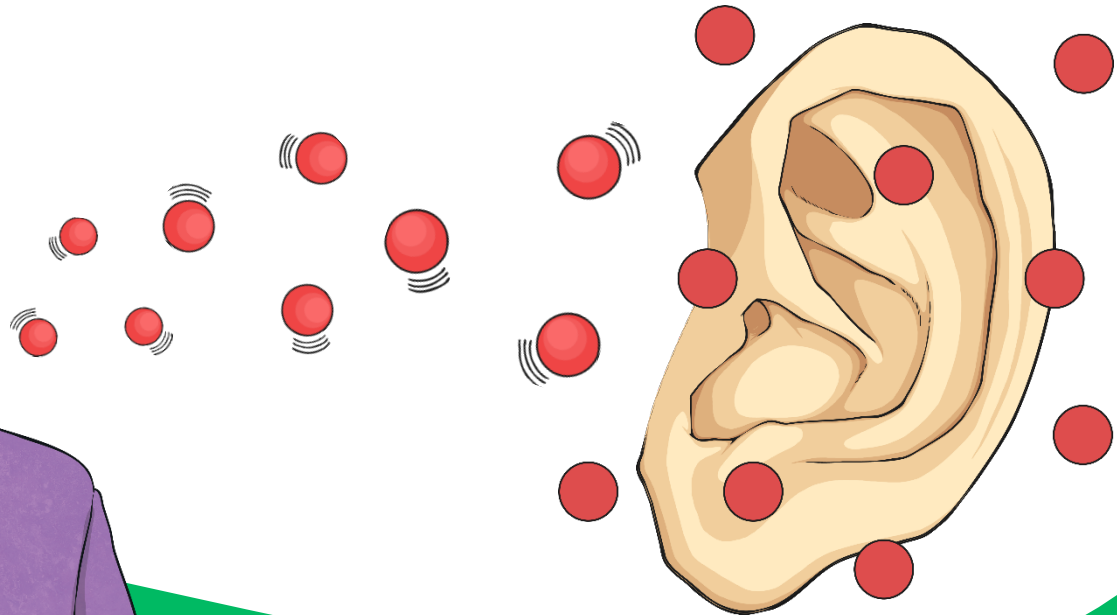
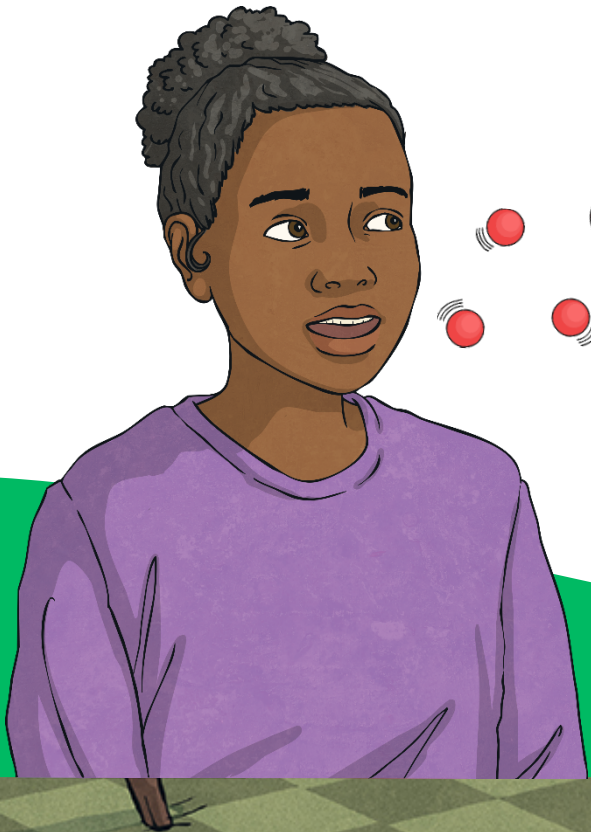


Hearing Your Presentation
