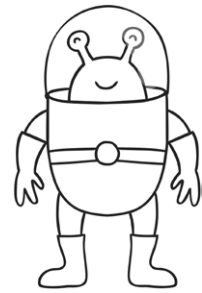
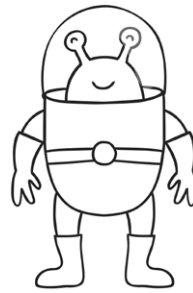
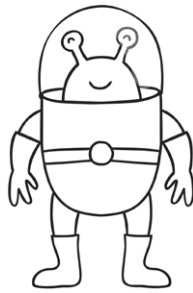
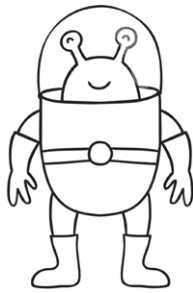
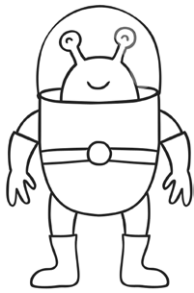


Alien Adverbials
