English

History

Topic: What is a Monarch?

- Identify what a monarch is and the role of a monarch
- Learn about and explain what happens during a coronation celebration
- Identify and compare the two types of castles built by the Normans

Chronology:

- Explore how the role of a monarch has changed over time
- Sequence castles on a timeline
- Make comparisons between past and present monarchy

Computing

Topic: Creating Media - Stop Motion

- Create a flip book animation
- Take clear, in-focus photographs using a digital camera
- Upload images from the school network
- Decompose a story into smaller parts to plan a stop motion animation
- Create stop motion animations with small changes between images

PE

Topic: Ball Skills - Rackets, bats and balls.

- Throw or hit balls with accuracy towards a target
- Throw and hit accurately in game settings
- Throw and hit with improved accuracy in competitive situations and under pressure
- Use rackets safely, being aware of others around them
- Play against an opponent fairly and with good sportsmanship

Maths

Fractions

- Identify a whole and parts of a whole
- Identify equal and unequal parts
- Identify thirds, halves and quarters
- identify unit and non-unit fractions

Time

- Tell the time to the hour and half past the hour
- Tell the time quarter to and quarter past
- Tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes
- To know how many minutes in an hour, hours in a day, days in a week and weeks in a month/year

Science

Topic: Plant Growth

- Know what a plant needs in order to grow healthily
- Sequence the stages of a plant's life cycle
- Identify the influences humans have over plants in the environment
- Draw diagrams to represent stages of a plant's life cycle

Working scientifically:

- Observe & measure plant growth
- Set up comparative tests and observe them over time
- Record plant growth data in a table

PSHE

Topic: Citizenship

- Learn that different rules can apply in different situations.
- Explain what makes a good school environment
- Identify some jobs people do to keep the local area pleasant
- Recognise similarities and differences between people in the local community and understand that differences should be respected

RE

Topic: How do some people talk to God?

- Understand and describe what prayer means
- Identify some reasons why people pray
- Explain how some people use their bodies during prayer
- Identify similarities and differences between the ways in which people pray
- Understand why special objects and items of clothing are important to some people when they pray.
