### REMINDER: Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check

Following on from our Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check meeting on 28th April, this is a reminder that the statutory check will take place during the two-week window starting **Tuesday 2nd June 2026 to Friday 12th June 2026**. This is a national assessment completed by all children in Year 4 to measure times table fluency.

During the check, the children will answer 25 questions covering times tables up to 12 x 12. Children have 6 seconds to answer each question, meaning the check takes less than 10 minutes in total. It will take place digitally with the class teacher in a calm, familiar environment. There is no official pass mark; the purpose is to determine if your child needs extra support. You will receive your child's total score with their End of Year report.

During the half-term holiday, we kindly request that parents and carers support their children by practising their times tables. You can do this by writing them down, using TT Rockstars, or using the practice websites uploaded to Google Classroom. Children may take their Chromebooks home over the holiday to practice as much as possible each day.

When we return from half-term, the class will continue daily practice until they complete their check. It is incredibly important that children arrive on time and are in school every day.

We have no doubt that the children will do well. They have worked incredibly hard throughout the academic year during daily times tables sessions and weekly homework.
