REMINDER & UPDATE: Year 6 Residential Trip: Scout Park, Bounds Green - Thursday 4th June 2026

The Year 6 children are really looking forward to their residential trip to Scout Park, Bounds Green on **Thursday 4th June 2026**. Please carefully read the updated information. We have included a packing list on the reverse of this letter and additional guidance below so pupils know exactly what they will need to bring. We are sending this information before the half term holiday to allow families time to source any additional items that may be needed and purchased.

Thursday 4th June 2026

- 8.45am** Children arrive as normal to school. Place their small hand luggage in the Reading Zone. Any medication must be given to the class teacher and signed
- 11.15am** Class will have early lunch
- 11.45am** Coach arrival to collect the children, who will make their way to Chesterfield Primary School. Then to Scout Park, Bounds Green

Friday 5th June 2026

- 11.45am** Coach to collect the children from Scout Park
- 12.00pm** Children will arrive at Delta. The children will place their belongings in the Reading Zone
- 12.30pm** Lunch at school
- 1.30pm** All children to be collected early and taken home (younger siblings will not allowed to leave early)

Before the trip, parents/carers will need to:

- Ensure their child has all items listed on the packing list.
- Check that the school has the most up-to-date contact and medical information.
- Share any additional information that may help support their child during the trip.

Packing List

Helpful Tips

- We are only staying **for 1 night**, so please pack lightly.
- Please take the time to pack with your child so they know what they have brought and can repack their belongings before returning home.
- Please make sure that all belongings are clearly named.
- Bonus points if the sleeping bag and pillow fit inside the main bag!
- Please do not pack sweets, snacks or treats. We will be providing plenty for the children.
- Children should only bring a bag they can carry themselves.
- Outdoor activities can be muddy and messy, so please only bring items that you do not mind getting dirty, damaged or lost.

Please Pack

- Sleeping bag and pillow (*either inside the bag or in a separate named bin liner*)
- A single bed sheet
- Water bottle
- 2 t-shirts
- Spare jumper or hoodie
- 1 pair of trousers or shorts (*weather dependent*)
- 1 pair of underwear
- 2 pairs of socks
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Torch or head torch
- Warm pyjamas (*long sleeves and trousers recommended*)
- Reading book
- Depending on the weather, wellies may be required - we will inform you closer to the time.

- T-shirt
- Jumper or hoodie
- Tracksuit bottoms or trousers
- Waterproof jacket or coat
- Old trainers

- Mobile phones
- Electronic devices, including cameras and gaming devices
- Any medication that has not been handed to teachers
