Can you think of a 'rhyme' that will help us remember the 4 points of a compass? E.g Never Eat Slimy Worms!

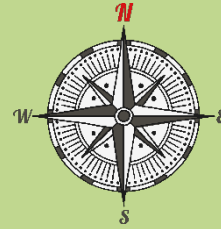
